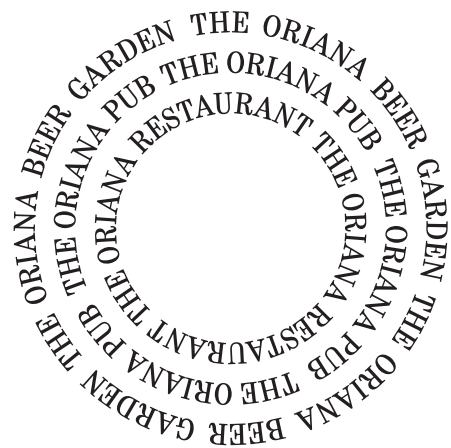

2016 Moet & Chandon Grand Vintage • Epernay, France	44	210
This is the 77th vintage of the prestigious Champagne house, Moet & Chandon. Each vintage is unique and highlights the harvest that year. 2016 was a turbulent year with a rainy spring and a dry summer that matured the grapes to a freshness that balances with the textural traditional method winemaking of Champagne.		
2023 Domaine de la Jolive Sancerre • Loire Valley, France	29.5	140
Domaine de la Jolive Sancerre comes from a small family-run Loire Valley estate, where meticulous vineyard management and sustainable practices shape the fruit. Traditional winemaking with gentle pressing and temperature-controlled fermentation preserves crisp citrus, flinty minerality, and vibrant acidity, delivering classic Sauvignon Blanc elegance with freshness, balance, and a clean, expressive finish. Drink this with freshly shucked oysters.		
2023 Domaine Thierry Mothe Chablis AC • Burgundy, France	28	135
Domaine Thierry Mothe Chablis AC comes from a multi-generational family estate in northern Burgundy, focused exclusively on Chardonnay and expressing classic Kimmeridgian limestone terroir. Sustainable vineyard practices and stainless steel fermentation with lees ageing preserve purity, delivering crisp citrus, green apple, and flinty minerality with vibrant acidity and a clean, elegant finish.		
2023 Bachelet-Monnot Chassagne-Montrachet • Burgundy, France	65	310
Chassagne-Montrachet is a sub region of the Cote de Beaune in Burgundy that produces world class Chardonnay. A newer venture in Burgundy, Bachelet-Monnot owns several parcels of land and been making wine since 2005. Clean but concentrated, gently oaked, regal and complex yet undeniably crushable. This wine adores seafood but also stands on its own.		
2023 Benjamin Leroux Savigny-Les-Beaune • Burgundy, France	62	295
The best Pinot Noir in the world comes from Burgundy and Savigny-Les-Beaune a smaller village within has an excellent reputation for both value and prestige. Benjamin Leroux has been making wine in Burgundy for the last 20 years. This wine is delicate, summery, and veratile enough to go with steak, fish, or just a sunset.		
2019 Penfolds St Henri Shiraz • Multi-Regional, SA	40	190
An icon of the Penfolds line-up, St Henri is a much-loved multi-regional Shiraz, where the very best parcels of fruit are fermented & matured in large format old French oak. Expect waves of red & black fruit, old leather & tobacco, while the palate is rich, long, and just the wine for dry aged steak & slow braised meats.
